Canberra Country Music Awards Competition

Rules & Conditions of Entry

Please read carefully, understand and retain these rules of entry and participation

The 2013 Canberra Country Music Awards provides recognition and incentives to Country Music performers, engineers and arrangers, and recognises their achievements on both a national and regional basis. It is unique, in that both regional contestants and national contestants compete against each other in the one competition, but recognition of local achievements is given in addition to any national achievements and includes awards for international entrants..

Anyone within Australia is eligible to win the **national level** of an award.

Anyone resident outside Australia is eligible to win the **international level** of an award.

Anyone born or resident in the Canberra Region is eligible to win the **regional level** of an award. (The Canberra Region is defined as; the Australian Capital Territory and surrounding region. The surrounding region is defined geographically as; the Illawarra and NSW South Coast, NSW Southern Highlands, NSW South West Slopes, Snowy Mountains and Riverina regions consisting of the local government areas of; Albury, Bega Valley, Berrigan, Bland, Bombala, Boorowa, Carrathool, Conargo, Coolamon, Cooma-Monaro, Cootamundra, Corowa, Cowra, Deniliquin, Eurobodalla, Goulburn-Mulwaree, Greater Hume Shire, Griffith, Gundagai, Harden, Hay, Jerilderie, Junee, Kiama, Leeton, Lockhart, Murray, Murrumbidgee, Narrandera, Palerang, Queanbeyan, Shellharbour, Shoalhaven, Snowy River, Temora, Tumbarumba, Tumut, Upper Lachlan, Urana, Wagga Wagga, Wakool, Weddin, Wingecarribee, Wollongong, Yass Valley, and Young.)

2013 LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD - *For distinguished service to Country Music and/or the Community in general.*

GENERAL

A fee of \$25.00 per category must accompany each recording title entry submitted. Applications without the fee, or with the incorrect fee, will be not be accepted.

Compositions are restricted to entries that are identifiable as Country Music by the majority of the judges. Sub-genre allocation will be as determined by information supplied in the entry form.

Accuracy of entry information is entirely the responsibility of the entrant. Competition organisers cannot be held responsible for omissions or inaccuracies.

Copyright of submitted material remains the property of the performer, songwriter/publisher and record label, for their respective rights and interests. Entrants indemnify the Competition organisers against any claim or loss resulting from non-compliance with copyright law.

By entering, the Entrant agrees that entry material may be used by the Canberra Country Blues & Roots Festival for promotional purposes. This may include placing samples of the music and reproduction of lyric's on the organiser's website, production of promotional compilation compact

discs, and possible live performance and broadcast at competition award presentations with composer credits also noted.

All entries will be rendered anonymous and numbered prior to judging. The judges' decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into subsequent to the announcement of final awards. The organisers and judges reserve the right to disqualify entries that do not comply with these rules & conditions.

There is no limit to the number of entries that may be submitted, but a separate form is required for each recording title submitted. A recording can be entered for a number of awards on each form, provided the appropriate entry fee is paid.

Entered material will not be returned unless a stamped self addressed envelope is provided. The organisers take no responsibility for entries misdirected, lost, stolen, or not received.

By entering, the Entrant agrees that their Awards presentation photographs and video may be used by the Canberra Country Blues & Roots Festival for subsequent promotional purposes, such as on the event website, future Award presentations and promotional DVDs.

Notifications and correspondence with entrants will be by email, where an email address has been supplied, including the results of the Awards, otherwise telephone contact will be made as far as practical at the time.

Trophies and/or Framed Certificates are provided to winners at the Award presentation. If the winners are not present at the Award presentation unframed Certificates will be posted to the address given in this Entry Form, with no Trophies provided, unless otherwise arranged with organisers prior to the close of the Award presentation.

All Entrants and supporters (family & friends) are entitled to discount Earlybird 3-day Festival Pass where the words "CCMA13 [contestant name]" is entered in the field "Club/Group" on the online registration form or downloaded forms.

RECORDINGS SUBMITTED MUST BE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING FORMATS:

- original CD. This is mandatory for Best Country Album & Best Extended Play CD entries – both of which require 5 copies to be provided with entry form; or
- audio CD recorded in either Mp3, Wav, or WMA formats with each song clearly identified by title & performer as identified on the entry form.

Note: Entrants are encouraged to test the format to be submitted as songs received in a format unplayable will not be judged. Multiple songs can be submitted on a single CD.

Winning recordings are announced & presented at the Canberra Country Music Awards held in Canberra during the Canberra Country Blues & Roots Festival.
