All entries will be rendered anonymous and numbered prior to judging. The judges' decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into subsequent to the announcement of final awards. The organisers and judges reserve the right to disqualify entries that do not comply with these rules & conditions.

Notifications and correspondence with entrants will be by email, where an email address has been supplied, including the results of the Awards.

There is no limit to the number of entries that may be submitted, but a separate form is required for each song submitted. A song can be entered for a number of awards on each form, provided the appropriate entry fee is paid.

Entered material will not be returned unless a stamped self addressed envelope is provided. The organisers take no responsibility for entries misdirected, lost, stolen, or not received.

SONGS SUBMITTED SHOULD BE AS PRESENTED AS FOLLOWS:

- on an original CD. This is a requirement for Best Country Album & Best Extended Play CD entries; or
- on an audio CD recorded in either *mp3, *wav, or *wma formats. Songs received in a format unplayable will not be judged. Multiple songs can be submitted on a single CD; or
- as an MP3 file with each song clearly identified by title & sender as identified on the entry form.

The Canberra Country Music Awards will be presented at the Canberra Country Music Festival on Sunday 20th November 2011.

Conditions of Entry

Please read carefully, understand and retain these rules of entry and participation

Basis

The 2011 Canberra Country Music Awards provides recognition and incentives to Country Music performers, engineers and arrangers, and recognises their achievements on both a national and regional basis. It is unique, in that both regional contestants and national contestants compete against each other in the one competition, but recognition of local achievements is given in addition to any national achievements.

Anyone within Australia is eligible to win the national level of an award.

Anyone within the Canberra Region is eligible to win the regional level of an award.

The Canberra Region is defined as; the Australian Capital Territory and surrounding region. The surrounding region is defined geographically as; the Illawarra and NSW South Coast, NSW Southern Highlands, NSW South West Slopes, Snowy Mountains and Riverina regions consisting of the local government areas of; Albury, Bega Valley, Berrigan, Bland, Bombala, Boorowa, Carrathool, Conargo, Coolamon, Cooma-Monaro, Cootamundra, Corowa, Cowra, Deniliquin, Eurobodalla, Goulburn-Mulwaree, Greater Hume Shire, Griffith, Gundagai, Harden, Hay, Jerilderie, Junee, Kiama, Leeton, Lockhart, Murray, Murrumbidgee, Narrandera, Palerang, Queanbeyan, Shellharbour, Shoalhaven, Snowy River, Temora, Tumbarumba, Tumut, Upper Lachlan, Urana, Wagga Wagga, Wakool, Weddin, Wingecarribee, Wollongong, Yass Valley, and Young.

GENERAL
